## Funding

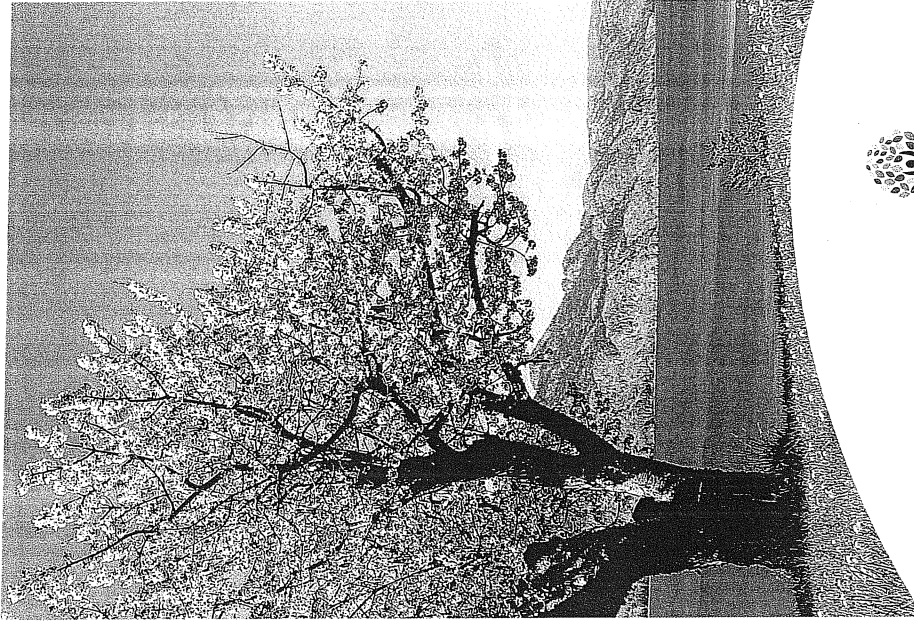

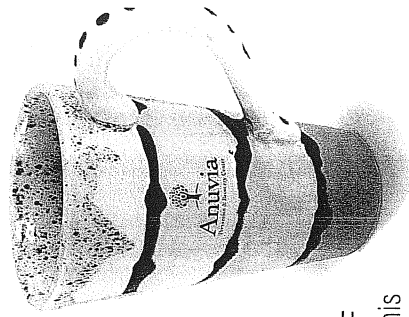


### Dance Nite
