

JUMPSTART COMMUNITY SAFETY MICRO-GRANTS

The City of Charlotte is offering micro-grants up to \$500 per project for non-profits and grassroots organizations to help jumpstart efforts that:

- Resolve conflict and encourage mediation
- Fight or prevent crime
- Give opportunities for youth and/or parents

To qualify, an organization must:

- Serve a public good within the city
- Have an annual operating budget of <\$100K
- Have projects that align with the efforts listed above
- Attend a pre-application session

Organization does not have to be a 501(c)3 to receive these grants.





Program Process

- Attend a pre-application session
- Submit an application and project budget for evaluation
- Organizations that receive a grant must complete the project by June 30, 2018, submit a report and receipts, and participate in a project showcase event in fall 2018
