Community Service Grants Update

Mecklenburg County will hold an information session for its Fiscal Year 2020 Community Service Grants (CSG) on Wednesday, Oct. 24, 2018 at 1 p.m. in Room 267 of the Charlotte-Mecklenburg Government Center.

Nonprofits will be asked to apply under one of seven community-facing key themes. All applicants must have current 501(c)(3) nonprofit status, submit audited financial statements, and serve the residents of Mecklenburg County. The grant award funding period is July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. The CSG application will be available Oct. 24 through Dec. 3, 2018.

Any nonprofit that has received funding for three consecutive fiscal years (FY2017 – FY2018 - FY2019) will undergo sunset review and can apply to become a vendor with the County. Funding for FY20 is not guaranteed. If a nonprofit is selected as a vendor, the agency will no longer compete in the CSG process.

Please be advised that notices will be sent to these nonprofits in advance of the information session. You may be contacted by these nonprofits requesting your support to convert them to a vendor. Similar to prior years, the Board will have an opportunity to receive a complete update on the CSG process during the FY2020 budget process.

County to Hold Ribbon-Cutting Ceremony for First Community Resource Center

Next Wednesday, Oct. 17, we will hold a ribbon-cutting ceremony for the first of six planned Community Resource Centers (CRC) in the County. The ceremony will take place at the Valerie C. Woodard Center, 3205 Freedom Drive, Suite 1000 from 9 – 10:30 a.m.

Since its initial opening in early June, the CRC on Freedom Drive has provided integrated health and human services to more than 18,500 people. This amounts to a 46-percent increase in number of customers served daily.
