



What is the **RISE2Work** Food and Nutrition Employment & Training (FNS E&T) Program?

- Department of Social Services program that connects customers to:
 - Free classes at **CPCC** and other training providers
 - Free training and certifications for in-demand jobs
 - Support services (including transportation assistance)
 - **Education Navigators** will help plan education and career paths

Eligibility:

1. Must be receiving Food and Nutrition Services for themselves or in someone's case in Mecklenburg County, Charlotte, NC.
2. Age 18-59
3. Must be able to work, i.e. not disabled
4. Cannot already be receiving Work First or Refugee Employment Services
5. Cannot incur a cost for child care to participate
