By implementing our Teens TOGETHER curriculum, and by serving as a liaison between with each participant's school, it is our goal to serve as a partner of education.

Why after school programs for adolescents matter:

The hours between 3 and 6 p.m. are the peak hours for juvenile crime and experimentation with drugs, alcohol, cigarettes and sex.

Self-care and boredom can increase the likelihood that a young person will experiment with drugs and alcohol. Ages 12-15 are the years in which youth develop their patterns of alcohol, tobacco, and other drug use or nonuse.

Afterschool programs can provide the extra time for career exploration and skills development that will prepare adolescents for high school, college and the workforce.

An analysis of 68 afterschool studies concluded that high quality afterschool programs can lead to improved attendance, behavior and coursework. Students participating in a high quality afterschool program went to school more, behaved better, received better grades and did better on tests compared to non-participating students.
