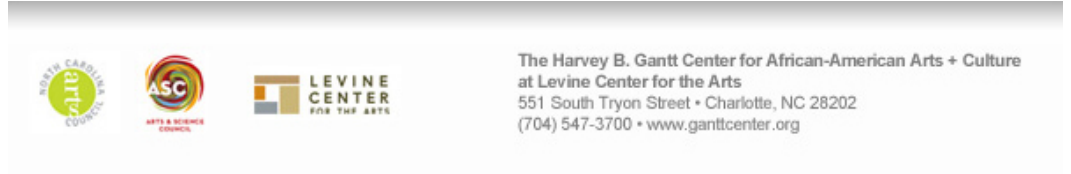
## Join us Thursday, June 19, 2014 for our 40th Anniversary Media Day.
