Code Enforcement Independent Review Project

Gartner Inc. has been hired by Mecklenburg County to perform an independent review of Code Enforcement services. Mecklenburg County served as the host site for the National Recreation and Park Association's (NRPA) 2014 National Congress from Oct. 14-16. The three-day conference took place at the Charlotte Convention Center and drew more than 7,000 park and recreation professionals, citizen advocates, and industry suppliers for networking opportunities, educational sessions, and the industry's largest trade show featuring nearly 400 exhibitors.
