I would like to inform you that we have hired an executive search firm, Waters & Company, to assist us in the recruitment of an Economic Development Director for the County.

The position was posted on the County's website on Dec. 19. A marketing brochure also has been developed which includes not only the job description, required qualifications, hiring salary range, and benefits, but a profile of the ideal candidate, an overview of the application and selection process, and some general information about Mecklenburg County (both community and government).
