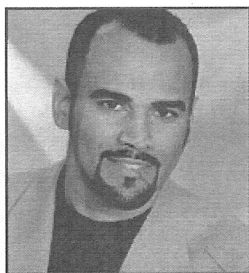
A conference you do not want to miss! Teachers, administrators, parents, community leaders, and all middle school males of color are invited to attend.

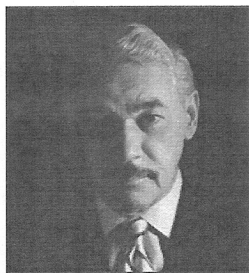
Sessions for educators will focus on cultural issues related to public education, as well as strategies, interventions, programs, and resources to improve the quality of education for all students.

Powerful, national speakers and local leaders from the community will discuss cultural issues and best practices to improve the quality of education for all children, especially children of African descent.

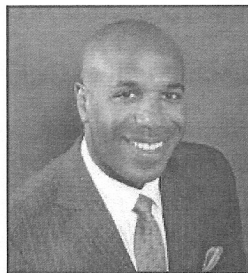

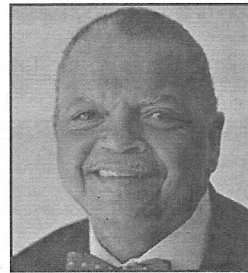
