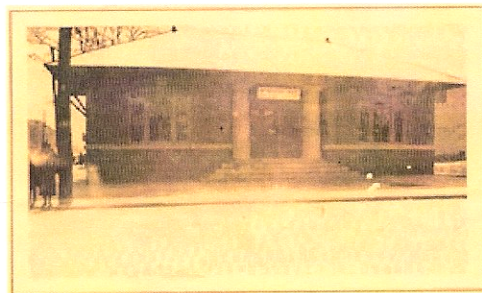


Remembering Brevard Street Library 1905-1961
