SAFE Coalition NC needs your help in promoting our Virtual Lobby Day in support of the Prohibition of Discriminatory Profiling bill. Over the past 6 months, we have been organizing and lobbying for the bill's passage in the NC General Assembly. In May, we held a successful Lobby Day at the NC General Assembly which many of you attended.

Since then, the conservative led NC General Assembly has ignored our appeal to have H193 scheduled to be heard in the House Judiciary Committee. This obstruction is reminiscent of the conservatives in the US Congress attempt to hold up Loretta Lynch's appointment as US Attorney General. Obstruction will not be tolerated!

Our Virtual Lobby Day is scheduled for July 28th and here is how you can help:
