### County Sets FY17 Grant Process for Nonprofits

Mecklenburg County held an information session today for nonprofits to learn how the County's Request for Proposal (RFP) process works and how they can apply for Community Service Grants for Fiscal Year 2017.

The County funds nonprofit services that contribute to the following target areas: improving the high school graduation rate, preventing health risks and disease, and promoting financial self-sufficiency. Last year, the CSG process underwent changes to improve controls, accountability and alignment to the County's processes while supporting nonprofits' self-sufficiency.

The grant award funding period is for FY17 (July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017). Beginning Oct. 16, the CSG application will be available here through Nov. 23, 2015.
