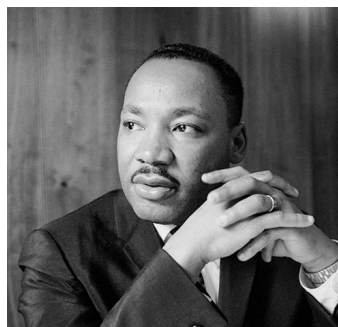
### Save the Date: Daniel Coston at the Charlotte Museum of History 15 January 2016, 6:00 pm - 9:00 pm
