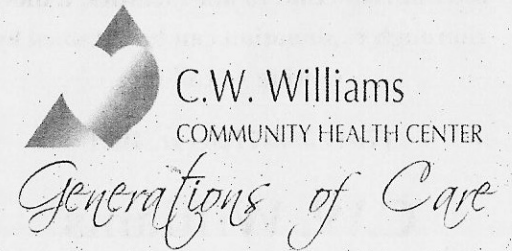

Convenient Payment & Insurance Options:

The program is designed to help patients receive accessible, affordable and quality healthcare for all services within the health center. We ask that you demonstrate your ability to pay by bringing income verification for your first visit, and I.D. and insurance card at each visit.

Payments and co-payments must also be made at each visit. For your convenience, a number of payment options are available including cash, check, VISA and Mastercard. Please note, the center accepts most major health insurance and HMO, Medicaid and Medicare.

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The Center also services uninsured patients and offers them discounted sliding fees based on federal poverty guidelines. When applying for this service you must demonstrate your ability to pay by:

1. Proof of household income such as paycheck stubs, income tax return or a letter from the Social Security Administration or Department of Social Services or a letter of employment verification.
2. Picture Identification—such as a drivers license or passport.
3. Proof of household size—such as birth certificates, tax returns that show number of dependents.

For nearly 35 years, The C.W. Williams Community Health Center, Inc. (CWWCHC) a Federally Qualified Community Health Center has been an anchor in the Charlotte community and continues to provide primary care, preventive care services, and health education.

In 1981, C.W.W.C.H.C along with other prominent community leaders petitioned the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services to create C.W. Williams Community Health Center, Inc.
