Open Streets 704 Update

In the July 5 edition of the Board Bulletin, I provided some preliminary information on the Oct. 23 Open Streets 704 event. I can now share information concerning the route and our public outreach

efforts for the event.

Our route will cover the neighborhoods of Biddleville, Smallwood, Seversville, Wesley Heights, Fourth Ward, Third Ward, Wilmore and South End.

Businesses and residents along the route will be notified so they can plan accordingly.

This Oct. 23 event will be the second of a series of four events made possible by a grant from the Knight Foundation. The first event in May drew approximately 10,000 participants on foot, bike, skateboards, rollerblades, and in strollers. Staff from the City of Charlotte and Mecklenburg County intend to use the four-event series to assess whether an ongoing Open Streets program makes sense for the community.
