JUSTIN MOORE SWORN IN TO NC HOUSE DISTRICT 92
Seated to the N.C. House of Representatives to replace Charles Jeter

Huntersville, NC - On Friday, August 26th, 2016, Justin Moore was sworn in as the new state representative for North Carolina's 92nd state house district. Moore, a Huntersville Republican and local attorney, had already been officially appointed to the seat by Governor Pat McCrory on Tuesday, August 22nd, 2016 to finish the term of retiring legislator Charles Jeter.

"It's a honor to serve my neighbors in the state legislature, and I want to do everything I can for them in my 128 days in office." Moore said after being sworn in. Moore was sworn in by Superior Court Judge Eric Levinson at the Huntersville Police Department's headquarters in front of a crowd of supporters.

Governor McCrory's appointment followed a vote by the Mecklenburg County Republican Party Executive Committee. On Wednesday, August 17th, 2016, the committee had voted to appoint Moore by a 83% to 17% margin.

The 92nd district stretches along western Mecklenburg County, from Huntersville in the north, through west Charlotte and unincorporated Mecklenburg county, to Pineville in the south.

Moore, 33, has a varied background including a Juris Doctorate from College of William and Mary Law School. He is admitted to practice in North and South Carolina. He also has a Bachelors of Science from Appalachian State University in Political Science and Criminal Justice. He is also a fellow of the Institute of Political Leadership (IOPL).
