Hi Steve!

My name is Autumn Watson and I just recently took over for Liz Hudgens as the Mecklenburg County local coordinator for the My Body, My Test program through UNC. I also work for the Mecklenburg County Health Department in the Environmental Health department and have for the past 10 years primarily on the west side of Charlotte.

I had notes that my predecessor Liz had contacted you regarding the Tuesday Morning Forum and given you some information regarding our project. I wanted to follow up with you to see if there is anything that I can provide and if we can get the My Body, My Test information back out to the Tuesday Morning Forum attendees. Previously we received several contacts from community groups that heard about the study through the forum earlier in the year.

As I'm sure that Liz explained earlier in the year, the goal of the project is to learn more about how to help women get screened for cervical cancer. Participant criteria is: low income women, aged 25-65 who do not have insurance and have not had a pap smear in the past 4 years.

Participants in the study will do 2 phone surveys and will have the chance to get free cervical cancer screening. Participants will be paid \$25 for each phone survey. It is the participants choice whether or not to get cervical cancer screening.

I am looking for community partners to help spread the word to these women especially since it is a tough demographic of women but the ones in the most need.

At your convenience, please let me know what I can get to you or if there is anything that I can do to get the word out about the study to the forum and what we are trying to accomplish in preventing cervical cancer in women in Mecklenburg County.
