**CANDIDATE FOR NC ATTORNEY GENERAL, Senator Josh Stein will be our speaker.** Senator Stein represented District 16 in the North Carolina Senate. His colleagues elected him the Democratic Whip, and he served on the Commerce, Education, Health Care, Finance, Judiciary I, and Rules Committees. He has earned many awards from conservation to Equality.

- For the eight years preceding his becoming a Senator, Senator Stein served as North Carolina's Deputy Attorney General for Consumer Protection, where he successfully took on predatory lenders and led efforts to crack down on sexual predators who use Internet sites to target children.
- The NC Justice Center honored Josh as the 2011 "Defender of Justice" for his dedication to expanding opportunity and prosperity for and North Carolinians.
- Before joining the Attorney General's office, Josh worked in the United States Senate.
- After graduating from Harvard Law School and the Harvard Kennedy School of Government, Josh worked with the Self-Help Credit Union in Durham, transforming abandoned drug houses into single-family homes.
- Josh taught high school English and economics in Zimbabwe for two years after finishing Dartmouth College.
- Today, Josh is of counsel with the law firm Smith Moore Leatherwood and is an adjunct faculty member at Campbell Law School.
