The conference is the kick-off event of the FY2018 budget season. The packed agenda for the two-day conference includes briefings on fiscal policies and the financial status of the County. The full agenda will be available on www.mecklenburgcountync.gov later this week.

The Board will also receive briefings from directors who will highlight service delivery and challenges the agencies are experiencing.

Mecklenburg County Drug Treatment Court Receives Grant Through Children and Family Futures

I am pleased to announce that Mecklenburg County's Families in Recovery to Stay Together program has been named by Children and Family Futures (CFF) as one of four grantees for the second round of the Prevention and Family Recovery (PFR) initiative.

The grantees will receive a three-year grant (Jan. 1, 2017 – Dec. 31, 2019) totaling \$300,000. CFF complements this direct financial support with a dedicated PFR change team to provide each grantee with intensive technical assistance, training and coaching to help achieve their goals.
