10 Years In Business Genesis Project Is Adding Transitional and Emergency Housing

At 10 years, Genesis is still seeking innovative ways to meet the needs of the community. In 2017, we are launching a new transitional and emergency housing program for individuals experiencing mental health and addictions crisis.

Our plan is to model the structure of the housing program after the Oxford Homes but offer additional supports and services to assist participants in reaching their goals and establishing independence. With the housing program, Genesis also seeks to partner with area restaurants, churches, and community organizations to provide a daily meal, mentorship, a clothes closet, and family enrichment.

This coming weekend, on March 5th,2017 45 Students from Students Today Leaders Forever, STLF, East Lansing Michigan will volunteer a half day to assist Genesis in preparing the housing facility. Students Today Leaders Forever's mission is revealing leadership through service, relationships and action. They operate entirely with a self-created leadership structure call the Core Model. The Core Model is a system based on functionality and collective action, rather than hierarchy and position. The Core Model successfully engages hundreds of volunteer student leaders to facilitate volunteer project, paying forward. Genesis Project was chosen for the volunteer opportunity.

These students will be cleaning, painting, and decorating to enhance the appearance of the front lobby, the grounds and the rooms that Genesis will be occupying. Genesis will be operating our first transitional and emergency housing at 2400 Wilkinson Boulevard. And we are very thankful for being chosen!

The Student will come in Saturday night about 9:00pm from Michigan to Genesis' office 5104 Reagan Drive – Ste 5, 28206, where they will eat and sleep. They will get up to be at 2400 Wilkinson Blvd at 8:30am. They will do their volunteer services for 3 and 1.2 hours then get on their way to their next project. Genesis is looking for a great day!
