City Council Approved the first step of the Eastland Mall Site Redevelopment Plan

The City Council has decided to move forward with the Eastland Mall redevelopment plan. They voted to authorize City Manager Marcus D. Jones to negotiate and execute a contract with Jacobs Engineering Group Inc. This decision to continue the project I have been working on is an exciting advancement towards my goal of bringing new economic opportunities to East Charlotte.

Some of the goals used to guide redevelopment of the site include:

- Enhancing the perceptions of the Eastland area and East Charlotte
- Unifying local communities
- Creating connectivity and walkability for surrounding neighborhoods
- Taking advantage of natural features
- Create opportunity for civic development and equitable economic development


