Dear Friends:

State legislators worked fervently to clear legislation from their respective houses before the crossover deadline on Thursday, April 27. Lawmakers worked late into the night negotiating and garnering up support for their bills. A bill must have passed at least one chamber of the legislature by the deadline to stay alive for consideration this year. Stay tuned for a highlight of some of the bills which made crossover.

On April 22, Governor Roy Cooper vetoed [Senate Bill 68, Bipartisan Board of Elections and Ethics Enforce](#) and [House Bill 239, Reduce Court of Appeals to 12 Judges](#). A three-fifths vote of both the House and Senate Chamber is required to override the Governor's veto. The bills were promptly overridden by the North Carolina General Assembly. Senate Bill 68 and House Bill 239 became law on April 25 and April 26 respectively.

Senate Bill 68 is another effort by the Republican party to combine the State Ethics Commission and State Board of Elections into a single board of eight members, evenly split between Democrats and Republicans. A judicial panel ruled that similar previous legislation was a violation of the separation of power clause of the N.C. Constitution. The State Board of Elections currently consists of five members, of which three are from the Governor's party.

House Bill 239 would reduce the number of judges on the Court of Appeals from 15 to 12 judges. This legislation interferes with the Governor's role in filling appointments as three Republican judges face retirement. This bill would also lead to a heavier workload for the remaining judges and longer delays in justice.

Crossover Update

- [**Class Size Requirement Changes \(House Bill 13/ S.L. 2017-9\)**](#) – This bill gives local school districts a one-year respite to adjust to K-3 class-size restrictions included in the 2016-17 state budget. For the 2017-18 school year, the average class size for grades kindergarten through third grade in a local school administrative unit cannot exceed 20 students. The size of an individual class cannot exceed 23 students. Local schools have to submit biannual reports that include information, such as the source of funds used for teacher salary and the number of program enhancement teachers. House Bill 13 was signed into law by the Governor on April 27.
- [**UNC Public Records/Athletic Conferences \(Senate Bill 323/House Bill 412\)**](#) – This legislation requires that any forms of communication between UNC System Universities and the National Collegiate Athletic Association (NCAA), Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC), or other athletic organization be subject to public records. This proposal is a reaction to the NCAA and ACC pulling championships from North Carolina due to the controversial bill, House Bill 2. It passed the Senate by a 37-12 vote, with most Democrats opposing the legislation, and will be sent to the House.
- [**Increase Teacher Supplement/Electric Notice \(Senate Bill 343/House Bill 432\)**](#) – This legislation allows city and counties to charge fees for publishing legal notices online. 50 percent of the fees collected to run online notices will be allocated to the county, while the other half will go to local salary supplements for teachers. Senator Joyce Waddell proposed an amendment for all of the fees to go toward teacher salary supplements, but bill backers tabled the proposal. Senate Bill 343 passed the Senate on April 25, with most Democrats opposing the bill. It is currently in the House for further consideration.
- [**Mecklenburg/Police Countywide Jurisdiction \(Senate Bill 5\)**](#) – Upon the approval by the Mecklenburg Board of Commissions, this bill authorizes the City of Charlotte police officers to exercise the same extraterritorial jurisdiction in Mecklenburg County as their municipality. There will be an agreement between the municipality and Mecklenburg County which sets guidelines to implement the act. Senate Bill 5 passed the Senate unanimously on April 24. It is currently in the House for further review.
- [**Honor UNC Men's Basketball 2017 Championship \(House Joint Resolution 921\)**](#) – On May 3, the House and Senate convened in a joint session to honor the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill men's basketball team for winning the NCAA Tournament last month. The General Assembly expressed appreciation and recognized the perseverance of the Tar Heels.

Governor Roy Cooper Vetoes Senate Bill 68 and House Bill 239

CHARLOTTE, NC - On Friday, Governor Roy Cooper vetoed Senate Bill 68, Bipartisan Board of Elections and Ethics Enforce, and House Bill 239, Re -due Court of Appeals to 12 Judges.

Senate Bill 68 is another effort by the Republican Party to combine the State Ethics Commission and State Board of Elections into a single board of eight members, evenly split between Democrats and Republicans. A judicial panel ruled that similar previous legislation was a violation of the separation of power clause of the N.C. Constitution. The State Board of Elections currently consists of five members, of which three are from the Governor's party.

House Bill 239 would reduce the number of judges on the Court of Appeals from 15 to 12 judges. This legislation interferes with the Governor's role in filling appointments as three Republican judges face retirement. This bill would also lead to a heavier workload for the remaining judges and longer delays in justice.

"I applaud Governor Roy Cooper's decision to veto Senate Bill 68 and House Bill 239. We must hold free and fair elections for every citizen. Similar legislation to merge the elections and ethics boards was already deemed unconstitutional. Instead of needless litigation, we should refocus our efforts on creating a better economy for everyone in North Carolina," said Senator Joyce Waddell.
