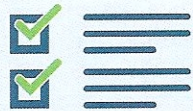

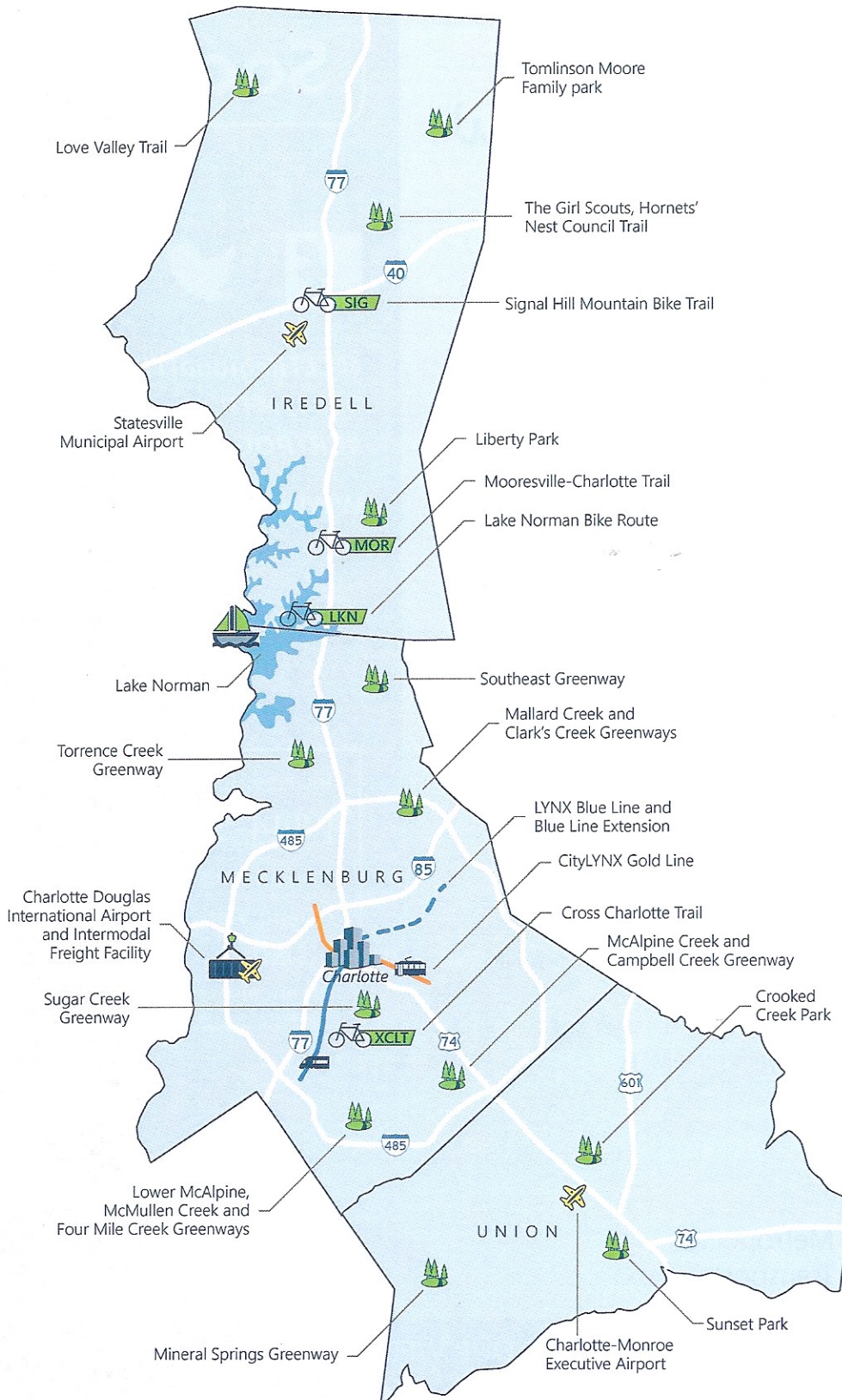

## MTP GOALS

1. Provide, manage, and maintain a safe and efficient transportation system for all modes. 
2. Encourage walking, bicycling, and transit options. 
3. Provide a sustainable transportation system that improves the quality of life for residents. 
4. Promote equitable transportation options for low income and minority neighborhoods, as well as the aging population. 
5. Encourage regional collaboration and linkages between transportation and land use planning. 
6. Support economic competitiveness and enhance system performance. 
7. Maximize travel and transportation opportunities for the movement of goods and people. 

## CRTPO FAST FACTS

- The population of the CRTPO planning area is approximately 1.3 million people and represents 14% of the entire population of NC.
- CRTPO consists of 29 member jurisdictions in Iredell, Mecklenburg, and Union counties.
- There are more than 6,800 miles of roadways in the CRTPO planning area.
