What is Health Care Justice - North Carolina?

Health Care Justice - North Carolina is a non-profit organization that advocates health care for all through a privately delivered, publicly funded single-payer system.

We operate as a chapter of Physicians for a National Health Program, a national non-profit research

and education organization.

What Do We Do?

We work to increase awareness and provide education about the benefits of a single-payer universal healthcare system. Look for us at community events such as parades and community festivals. Invite us to speak to your civic club, church or other community gathering.

We also monitor and advocate legislation that impacts health care in North Carolina. We encourage members to call and write elected officials and we organize constituent trips to meet with elected officials.

Why Change Our Current System?

Our current healthcare system has the highest administrative costs in the world, yet we rank near the bottom among high-income countries in nearly all health indicators.

Our third-party payer system relies on private insurance companies whose administrative costs, on average, fluctuate between 12% and 14% nationally. These private insurers impose tremendous administrative costs on doctors, hospitals and other providers.

By comparison, Medicare, a popular single-payer system already in place for senior citizens, has

administrative costs of about 2%.

What Difference Would a Single-Payer Health Care System Make to You?

- Quality health care for all privately delivered, publicly funded
- No insurance premiums
- No out-of-pocket costs such as co-pays and deductibles
- No cost for medications
- Freedom to choose healthcare providers
- Decisions about your health would be made by you and your provider
