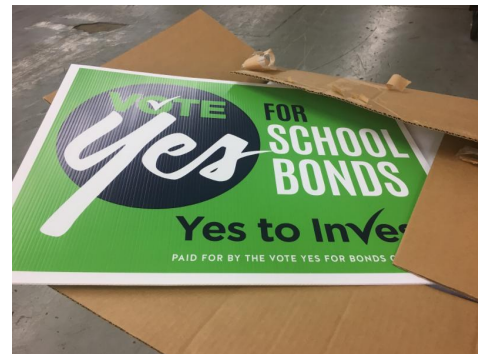

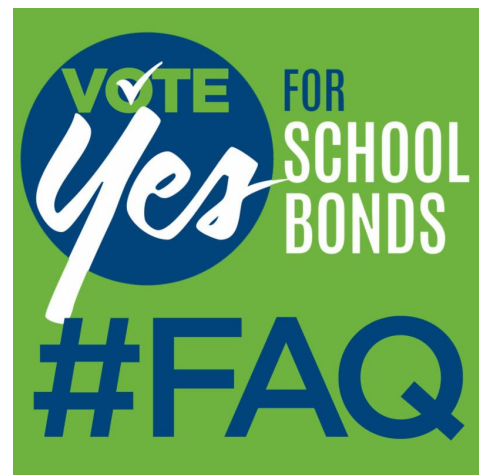
Frequently Asked Questions

Q: Will the 2017 bonds request cover all Charlotte-Mecklenburg Schools construction and renovation needs?

A: No. CMS has identified in its 10-year plan **more than \$2 billion** in projects that must be built. At \$922 million, the bonds package will cover 29 of the system's highest priority projects.

Project Spotlight

Included in the bond package is \$110.3 million to build a new high school in south Mecklenburg County. This new school would offer much needed relief to three overcrowded high schools -- South Mecklenburg, Ardrey Kell (photo above) and Myers Park.

Students at these schools deal with crowded hallways, media centers, gyms and cafeterias, which leads to accelerated wear and tear on the buildings. Some students even have lunchtimes as early as 10 a.m.
