Ford, Program Director of the Public Schools Form, N.C. and co-chair of “Leading on Democracy,” the council charged with implementing the Charlotte Opportunity Task Force’s recommendations, will speak at the LWVCM’s bimonthly Lunch with the League. The Task Force was formed in response to a Harvard study, which found Charlotte to rank at the bottom of the 50 largest cities in the U.S. for economic mobility.

The League has been particularly interested in the education aspects of this long-awaited report, and is privileged to host Mr. Ford, a 2014-2015 N.C. Teacher of the Year.
