
Who we are:








Programmed MTP Projects – All Modes









TRANSPORTATION FOR OUR GROWING TOMORIZOW

The Charlotte Regional Transportation Planning Organization (CRTPO) is the federally-designated Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) for the Charlotte region. The CRTPO conducts transportation planning activities throughout its planning area, which includes all of Iredell and Mecklenburg counties, and the majority of Union County.

The Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) defines policies, programs, and projects to be implemented over the next twenty-plus years for the regional MPO planning area. Through a collaborative process that includes stakeholder and public input, projects are evaluated to define priorities and anticipated funding is identified to support the transportation improvements and initiatives outlined in the plan. The MTP is updated often to stay current with changing needs.



Key Components of Project Programming

> The MTP establishes project priorities for the next 20+ years.

MTP GOALS

1. Provide, manage, and maintain a safe and efficient transportation system for all modes.



- 2. Encourage walking, bicycling, and transit options.

- 3. Provide a sustainable transportation system that improves the quality of life for residents.



- 4. Promote equitable transportation options for low income and minority neighborhoods, as well as the aging population.
- 5. Encourage regional collaboration and linkages between transportation and land use planning.
- 6. Support economic competitiveness and enhance system performance.



7. Maximize travel and transportation opportunities for the movement of goods.



CRTPO FAST FACTS

- · The population of the CRTPO planning area is approximately 1.3 million people and represents 14% of the entire population
- CRTPO consists of 29 jurisdictions in Iredell, Mecklenburg, and Union counties, 24 of which are voting members.
- There are nearly 7,000 miles of roadways in the CRTPO planning area.


