

Resource Conservation Workshop

June 25-30, 2017 at NC State University



Resource Conservation Workshop (RCW) is a five-day training camp that brings together a diverse group of students from across North Carolina. The primary objective of the program is to learn about natural resources and their management in today's environment (forest management, soil characteristics and soil conservation, non-agricultural uses for soils, water quality and watershed management, and wildlife and fisheries management). Students are housed in NCSU campus dormitories under the guidance of live-in counselors.

Who is eligible?

- Students who have demonstrated an interest in natural resource conservation
- Students that attend a school in Mecklenburg County
- High School freshmen, sophomores and juniors

- Submit your application to the MSWCD. A Letter of Recommendation from a teacher, a principal or a guidance counselor is favorable; however, it is not a requirement
