


The Urban League's Fiber Optic/Broadband curriculum is designed to develop skills including, the use of hand tools, various cable installation techniques, the use of computerized equipment, and safety regulations and concerns. Upon completion, participants are prepared to sit for the Certified Premise Cabling Technician and the Certified Fiber Optic Technician exams offered through the Fiber Optic Association (FOA).



Residential & Commercial Construction

Goodwill's six-week, 96-hour Entry Level1 Construction Training provides instruction in construction math, blueprint reading, hand and power tool use, safety training, a 10-hour OSHA Construction compliance training, and "soft skills" needed for employment such as interviewing and resume writing.



The Urban League's NCDOT Construction and Trade Academy prepares clients for a career in construction or the trades with instruction in the following: construction math; hand and power tool use and safety training. The Academy also provides training including a 10-hour OSHA, TIMS (Traffic Incident Management Safety-Responder) as well as "core skills" needed for employment such as interviewing and resume writing.

Dynamic teams of instructors will assist clients with resume writing, interview skills and job placement.
