

Eligibility & Credit

This program is open to all students entering into 6th through 13th grades (first year in college) in the fall of 2018. Students should have less than 2 years of experience learning Chinese (Mandarin)—this includes both students who might have studied Chinese in formal contexts (school, including weekend Chinese schools and previous STARTALK Chinese programs) or in informal contexts (at home, traveling, etc.). Students may have experience studying other foreign languages. No academic language credit will be awarded to students participating in this program.

Costs

Participation in the program is free to all student participants. All participants are responsible for their own transportation and meals, though snack will be provided daily. As this is a non-residential program, housing will not be provided to participants.

Teacher Recommendation

The recommendation form must be completed and emailed to pds.startalk@gmail.com by a teacher who has taught the student applicant in the 2017-2018 school year. The student application will not be considered complete until the teacher recommendation has been received.
