**Mecklenburg Council of Elder's Receives \$15,000 Grant  
from United Way's Unite Charlotte to Support Expungement**

Mecklenburg Council of Elder's (MCOE) is thrilled to announce that we are the recipients of a \$15,000 grant from the United Way's Unite Charlotte. This marks the first year that the organization has received funding for their community work that is being done in the area of criminal justice. And, we extend our deep gratitude to Unite Charlotte for generously supporting criminal record expungement activism at this critical time in Charlotte and Mecklenburg County – Thus – forging forward with the history making collaboration of the clerk of courts through the District Attorney's office with the support of the public defenders, assistant public defender's and the entire court system.

This grant will partially support one of the core components of our current strategic plan: *to serve as a liaison between the community, CMPD and government: thus, creating a sense of safety, trust and job security by exploring new ways to break through systems of oppression and existing barriers to access.* The grant has been earmarked to support Criminal record expungement of over 3,000 people currently on our waiting list.
