The Reading Success Dashboard was launched in May 2017 and is intended to help the community visualize 2025 and exactly what it will take to get to 80% third grade reading proficiency by 2025.

Read Charlotte Receives National Honors



Each year, the Campaign for Grade Level Reading recognizes communities across the United States for innovation, impact and progress. This summer, Read Charlotte's Data Collaborative is being recognized under the Campaign's "Pacesetter" honor as one of the 29 communities working towards grade-level reading proficiency in an innovative way. The Data Collaborative, which was launched last year, is a way for communities, educators, nonprofit agencies and funders to use data to better understand what works to improve children's language and literacy skills across Charlotte-Mecklenburg.

Read Charlotte was also recognized with a "Bright Spot" award for launching the Reading Success Dashboard, the community data tool that makes it easier to track school-by-school progress.
