2018 Third Extra Session
Charlotte, NC- North Carolina State Legislators reconvened for a third special session Tuesday, October 2, to address Hurricane Florence recovery efforts. Senate Bill 2 (School Calendar and Pay/ Hurricane Florence) was introduced to facilitate compensation to school employees, flexibility in the school calendar year, and to provide relief to students enrolled in an educator preparation program. Senator Joyce Waddell co-sponsored Senate Bill 2 (School Calendar and Pay/ Hurricane Florence). This would allow that if the governing body of a public school unit closed any school due to unusual and extraordinary inclement weather conditions related to Hurricane Florence, calendar flexibility for instructional time missed due to Hurricane Florence during the months of September 2018 and October 2018. Employees employed by a public school unit shall be deemed to have been employed for any scheduled instructional days missed that a public school unit has completed and is not required to make up missed time. Employees shall be compensated in the same manner they would have had they worked on the scheduled instructional days missed. The board of directors of a charter school may, but is not required to, provide such compensation for its employee.

The Senate passed the bill.
"Our students and school staff deserve the flexibility with calendar. Hurricane Florence caused many lives to changes both mentally and financially. Whatever is needed for teacher compensation without loss of wages is imperative." Said senator waddell
