This means that the Schedule of Values, which was adopted by the BOCC on Sept. 18, is official as approved.

**Mecklenburg County Air Quality Wins \$1.6 Million Grant to Support AeroGRADE**

After a competitive application process, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency has selected [Mecklenburg County Air Quality](#) as the recipient of a \$1.6 million grant to support AeroGRADE (Airport Grants to Replace Aging Diesel Engines).

The funding will be used to convert up to 120 pieces of ground support equipment from diesel to electric models at Charlotte Douglas International Airport. The award also includes provisions to fund two diesel-to-electric demonstration projects focused on goods movement equipment.

The Charlotte region only narrowly meets the ozone health standard, and projects like AeroGRADE are an important part of Air Quality's strategy to create "[Breathing Room](#)" between our compliance value and the health standard.
