Bond Type	Funding	Summary
Housing	\$50 Million	Housing bond will fund the city's Housing Diversity Program to increase the supply of safe, decent and affordable housing for residents of all income levels throughout Charlotte.
Neighborhood Improvement	\$55 Million	Neighborhood improvement bonds will fund projects that address infrastructure needs in the city's established neighborhoods and emerging high-growth areas.
Transportation	\$118. 08 Million	Investments are intended to increase overall mobility by providing transportation choices, promoting access to transit and major transportation routes and improving connectivity within and between communities. With that in mind, the Community Investment Plan will continue investing in transit access, bridges, trails, sidewalks and streets.
