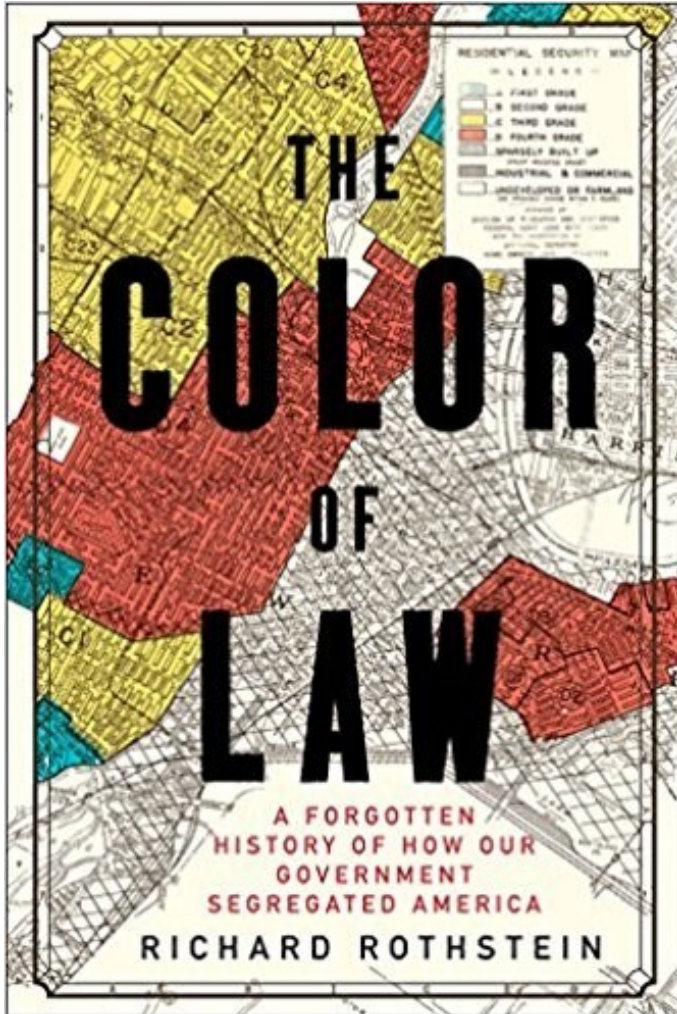


CHARLOTTE COMMUNITY BOOK READ
