Storm Water Services Sends Floodplain Flash Newsletter to Property Owners in Floodplain Areas

Charlotte-Mecklenburg Storm Water Services is making sure that property owners living or working in floodplain areas throughout the County have access to important information to help them protect their homes or businesses.

Earlier this month, Storm Water Services mailed its Floodplain Flash newsletter to 4,500 property owners in floodplain areas.

The newsletter plays a major role in the communication process required in keeping Charlotte's FEMA Community Rating System (CRS) rating at 4. The CRS rating of 4 allows City of Charlotte property owners in the floodplain to qualify for a 30-percent discount on flood insurance.

Articles featured in the newsletter include: Protect Your Family and Your Property, Construction in the Floodplain and Retrofit: Is Your Property Eligible for a Floodproofing Grant? The newsletter also features updated floodplain maps.

- Office of the Tax Collector (relocating from Bob Walton Plaza to VCW Suite 3000)
- School Health (relocating from the Hal Marshall Annex to VCW Suite 8500)

By moving these departments to the Valerie C. Woodard Center, our goal is to provide quality services in a location that's convenient for customers.
