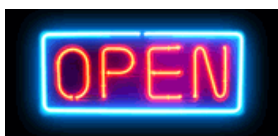
Couldn't make the conference call? See the questions and answers discussed during the call below.

- Q: Can program providers apply to one school or all three schools?
- A: Yes, program providers can apply to serve one, two, or all three schools based on their programming and budget.
- Q: Is the grant focused on offering programs during the school year or calendar year?
- A: The School Partnership grant is focused on offering expanded learning opportunities for scholars during the 2019-2020 school year.

- Q: What time does the school day end for the three partner schools?
- A: In the 2019-2020 school year, our partners will dismiss at the following times:
