To make it easy for parents and students, the [Mecklenburg County Public Health Department](#) is offering several Big Shots Saturday clinics this summer.

Clinics will take place from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. on the following dates at either the Southeast Health Department (249 Billingsley Road, Charlotte) or the Northwest Health Department (2845 Beatties Ford Road, Charlotte):

- June 22 –Southeast Health Department
- July 20 –Northwest Health Department
- Aug. 3 – Southeast Health Department
- Aug. 17 - Northwest Health Department
- Sept. 7 – Southeast Health Department
