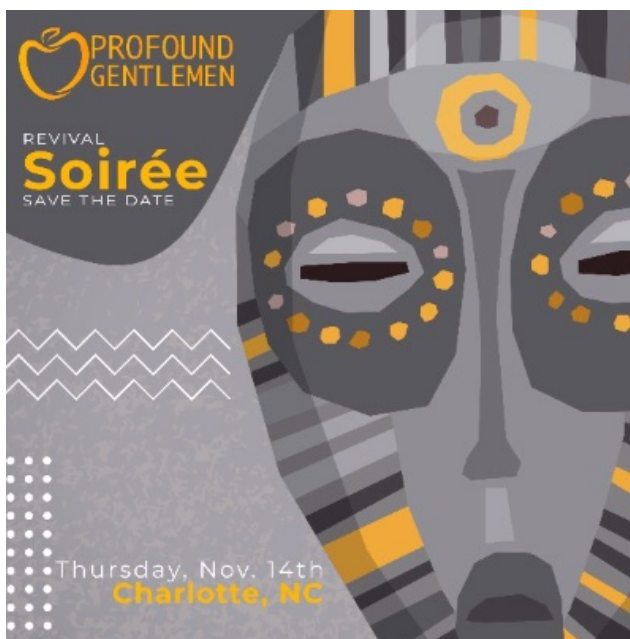


Its Been A Profound Year

be prepared for an unforgettable night.

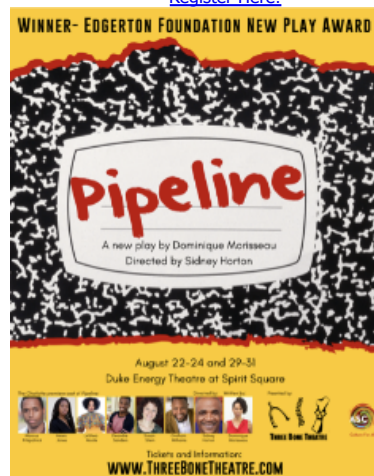

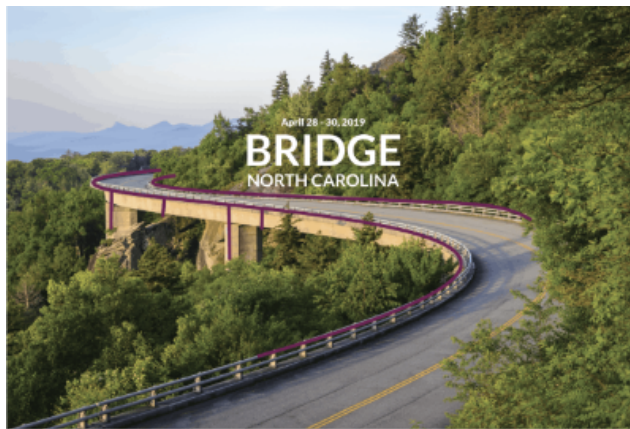
Pipeline
