- Since taking office in December 2017, every member of the current

city council has voted for developments that will create over 150,000 new car trips every day. How will we be able to fight climate change if we blindly vote for almost every rezoning?

- Right now, there is a crisis at the Lake Arbor apartment complex, and over 100 residents will be kicked out of their homes this weekend. How can Charlotte do more to help here?
- Would you vote for a change to city council ethics rules that prevents members of city council from accepting contributions from developers with business in front of the city?
- Do you support the Mecklenburg County sales tax increase? If not, where would you rather see the money go if it passes?

I'm ready to answer all of these questions and more at tonight's debate. Please tune in and talk about it on social media using the hashtags #QueenNewDeal and #CLTCC.

I'll close by saying this: we should expect candidates for city council to have a plan, because **it makes no sense for someone to go to all the trouble of serving on city council without knowing what they're fighting for.**
