The League of Women Voters Charlotte Mecklenburg welcomes Mecklenburg County Sheriff Garry L. McFadden to its **Lunch with the League** on September 11, 2019. The sheriff will discuss his accomplishments since taking office, his stance on immigration and future plans for the department.

McFadden was elected to office in 2018. Before becoming sheriff, he served on the Charlotte Mecklenburg Police Department for 36 years. During that time, he worked on more than 800 homicides of which 90% were solved. He retired from the police department in 2016.

In Mecklenburg County, the sheriff runs the jail, oversees security at the courthouse and serves court papers. The Mecklenburg County Sheriff serves a four-year term.
