While modern technology continues to make our lives easier and more convenient, the revolution in how we participate in our democracy remains incomplete. Someday, simple acts like voting or joining a town meeting will be as easy as shopping online or hailing a ride share—but not yet.

That's why Knight is making a [\\$3 million investment in Democracy Works](#) to make voting and civic participation easy and accessible in the digital age. Since 2010, Democracy Works has been at the forefront of applying technology's promise to the vital work of strengthening our democracy. [DETAILS ON OUR NEW INVESTMENT](#)

Knight's funding will support the scaling and growth of the organization's technologies, including its TurboVote platform, which develops tools for voters, gathers data for elections, and builds technology for election officials.


In 2018, more than 6 million subscribers of TurboVote received election information and reminders, tens of millions of people used the platform to find a polling location, and states throughout the country registered more than 125,000 polling places to the platform.

This support will also help Democracy Works launch a new, \$20 million funding push to bring TurboVote and its other digital tools to a mass audience — with the ultimate goal of increasing participation in elections.
