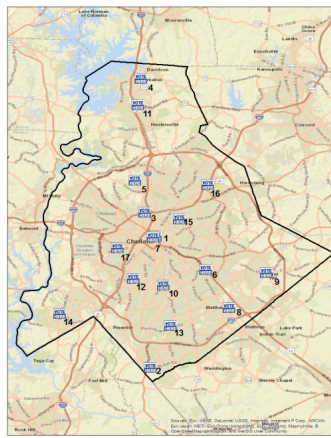
This is the last week for early voting. If you want to skip the line, vote now!
