Syringe Exchange Program Awarded Grant Funding

Earlier this month, the Public Health Department's Syringe Exchange Program was awarded \$550,000 in grant funding from the State to extend the program for two and a half years.

Through State funding and partnerships with <u>Center for Prevention Services</u> and <u>Carolinas Care Partnership</u>, the program sees an average of 100 people a week for syringe and homelessness services. By meeting basic needs and utilizing peer engagement, the program is able to reduce harms associated with drug use and homelessness.

The grant funds will be given to Public Health Department partners Center for Prevention Services and Carolinas Care Partnership to support the Syringe Exchange Program as well as host support groups and provide education. The Public Health Department will continue to provide guidance and oversight to the community partners.

Re-Entry Services hosts '30 Days Out' Simulation Event

On Tuesday, Dec. 17, Criminal Justice Services Re-Entry Services will host a simulation exercise to show the difficulties people with criminal records face during the first 30 days following their release. "30 Days Out" is a two-hour exercise targeted at law enforcement, district attorneys, the Public Defender's Office and other court officials.

The goal of the simulation is to highlight the obstacles faced by men and women attempting to navigate the system upon release from prison.

The event will also feature useful resources available through the County's re-entry partners.
