Litter Gitter Pilot Program Press Conference

Mecklenburg County Stormwater Services, the City of Charlotte, Coca-Cola Consolidated, Envision Charlotte and the Osprey Initiative will hold a press conference Tuesday to announce the new "Litter Gitter" pilot program. The goal of the program is to remove recyclable materials and other litter from the County's streams, while also gathering data and finding sustainable solutions for the future.

The press conference will be held at Alexander Street Park at 10 a.m.

Mecklenburg County's Land Use and Environmental Services Agency and Park and Recreation Department are significant contributors to the project by providing guidance and leadership, as well as providing solid waste facilities and access to 3 Litter Gitter installation sites along greenways at Alexander Street Park, Ray's Splash Planet, and Revolution Park.
