Calling all high-school students (16+), college students, teachers, and anyone looking for a summer job!

All Park and Recreation Divisions will be hiring **ON-SITE** for part-time summer positions and other vacancies.

We will be conducting interviews and drug tests **ON-SITE** for immediate hiring. Bring your swimsuit if you are interested in a Lifeguard position as **ON-SITE** swim tests will be required.

You will be asked to complete an I-9 Form, so please bring all appropriate identification documents. All acceptable I-9 documents can be found by visiting the Job Fair link at **parkandrec.com**.



PARKING ATTENDANT: Temporary summer positions (40 hrs/wk) that start in May and end in September. These positions carry out the parking plans set forth by the Lead Park Rangers. Typical duties include providing customer service along with maintenance duties when necessary. Must be able to work in all weather elements. Must be able to stand for long periods of time. Must be willing to work weekends and holidays. **Must be age 16 or older.**

LIFEGUARD: Temporary 9-week positions (40 hrs/wk) AND permanent part-time positions (19 hrs/wk) that will be responsible for ensuring a safe swimming environment for the general public. Specific duties include pool surveillance, providing first aid, delivering customer service and overseeing all swimming activities. Must be able to swim. **Must be age 16 or older.**

BOOTH ATTENDANT: Temporary summer positions (40 hrs/wk) that start in April and end in October. Responsible for taking cash and credit card payments from patrons in a busy environment. Typical duties include providing customer service, light general maintenance duties and assisting with parking as needed. Strong computer skills desired. Must pay close attention to detail. Must be willing to work weekends and holidays. **Must be age 16 or older.**

RECREATION ASSISTANT: Permanent part-time positions (19 hrs/wk) that assist with the day-to-day operations at a Recreation Center. Typical duties include customer service, front desk operations, assisting with recreation programs for all ages and setting up and cleaning facility for programs and events. **Must be age 18 or older.**
