

As you have likely heard by now, a Stay at Home Order has been issued for Mecklenburg County, effective at 8:00 a.m. on Thursday, March 26, 2020. Consequently, I wanted to share some important information and resources to help you stay updated during this time.

**The City of Charlotte will continue to provide essential services during this time. As an effort to keep employees safe, many are working from home or on staggered shifts. As a result, there may be additional wait times when contacting our offices and/or impacts on our services. Below is a list of some of the changes, however please see the City of Charlotte website for details and to stay current during this rapidly changing time.**


**CMPD:** As always, Call 911 in an emergency. In order to prevent 911 emergency lines open from being overwhelmed, residents are asked to report non-emergencies online.

**City Water:** There will be no disconnections until further notice. Charges are still being incurred, so Residents should contact Crisis Assistance Ministries for assistance with utilities and rent. and utilities.

**Solid Waste:** Trash and recyclables will be picked up weekly. There will not be bulk or yard pick up at this time.

**CATS:** Buses and LYNX will run on modified schedules. The Buses are Free until further notice.
