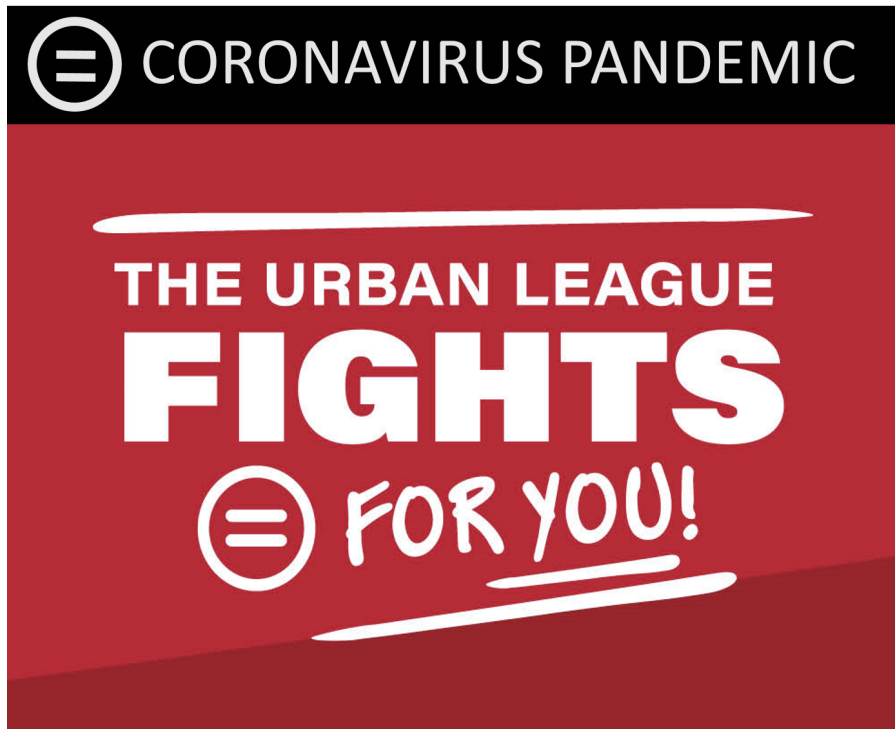

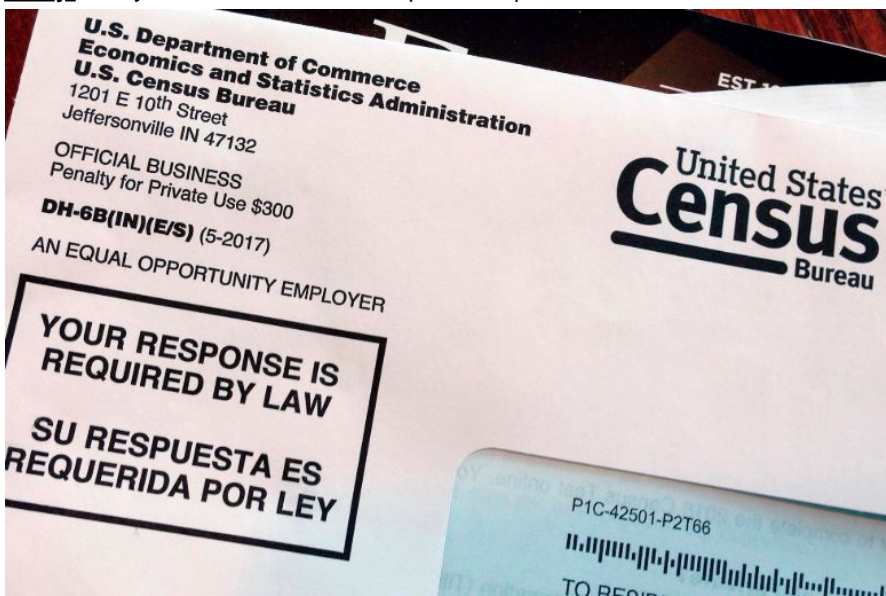

2020 Census Update - Make Black Count

As of May 9, 2020, 57.8% of households in Mecklenburg County have self-responded to the 2020 Census. This is below the 2010 self-response rate of 67.3%. Mecklenburg County is currently ranked 20 out of 100 counties in NC for Census response rates.
