Adams Statement on Trump Administration's Move to Shortchange National Guard Service Members

Charlotte – Today, Congresswoman Alma S. Adams, Ph.D. (NC-12) released a statement on the story, first reported by **Politico**, that the Trump administration plans to end National Guard deployments on June 24, one day before many National Guard Service Members qualify for benefits.

Finally, the move would threaten benefits and shortchange the men and women working to protect us."
